<p><b>Class 2</b></p> <p><b>NOVICE</b>          (Junior &amp; Senior)          Approx 11am start</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Fences between 80cm-90cm (2ft6" -2ft9")</li> <li>• Optimum time</li> <li>• Annual trophy to highest placed RLRC member</li> <li>• Combination of horse and rider must not have been placed 1<sup>st</sup> in any Cross Country or Hunter Trials. Members are referred to RLRC Rule Book</li> </ul>
<p><b>Class 3</b></p> <p><b>INTERMEDIATE</b>          (Junior &amp; Senior)          Not before 1pm</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Fences between 90cm-95cm (2ft 9" - 3ft)</li> <li>• Optimum time</li> <li>• Annual trophy to highest placed RLRC member</li> </ul>
<p><b>Class 4</b></p> <p><b>OPEN</b>          (Junior &amp; Senior)</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Fences between 95cm-1.05m (3ft-3ft 6")</li> <li>• Optimum time</li> <li>• Annual trophy to highest placed RLRC member</li> </ul>

## RULES

- Competitors must wear the correct standard hat with a harness properly adjusted and fastened. Hats marked EN1384, PAS015:1998, ASTM F1163, BSEN14572:2005 or SEI American standard SNELL E2001, ASTM95, SN3838 1998.
- Fixed Peak Hats are not permitted for Cross Country
- BODY PROTECTORS MUST BE WORN, MINIMUM PURPLE STANDARD (LEVEL 3) IF LOWER WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO COMPETE
- Standing martingales, time pieces and jewellery are **not** allowed
- It is highly recommended that all competitors wear medical arm bands
- Hair must be neatly secured and must not hang lower than the shoulder line (when standing normally)
- Juniors are riders under 18 years, and seniors are riders 18 years and over (age on Jan 1<sup>st</sup> 2010)
- Only competitors may work in a horse/pony before a class
- In the event of elimination, competitors may complete the course by moving on to the next fence after their third attempt, provided that they give priority to other competitors
- **Horses / Ponies are only allowed to compete twice.**
- A CASH deposit of £6 will be required on collection of the cross country vests, £5 will be returned and £1 will be donated to the Air Ambulance Charity. Please return the vest **immediately** after finishing the course to the Secretary's caravan.
- No refunds will be given for any withdrawals.
- **All riders must sign the declaration part of the entry form confirming that they will adhere to all the rules. If aged 16 or under, the parents need to sign.**
- No riding club membership will be taken on the day.
- Health and Safety regulations and notices must be adhered to.
- Children aged 16years and under **must not** be left unattended.
- Dogs must be kept on leads at all times.
