WELCOME TO REARSBY LODGE RIDING CLUB 2010

Welcome to members and non-members. In this schedule we have tried to include something for everyone, from the beginner to the more advanced rider, and we hope that you will find some classes to suit you. Entries will also be taken on the day except for dressage entries.

All dressage entries must be pre entered and times will be given prior to the show.

We always value comments and suggestions and wish you every success in 2010.

Please note: Classes marked with a (T) have a perpetual trophy to be won at the end of the year. Only RLRC members can compete towards these trophies, with points gained throughout the year. To be eligible for the perpetual trophy competitors must compete at least twice in the specific class throughout the year.

RULES

Would all Rearsby Lodge Members please refer to the rule book, which explains which classes you are eligible for during the 2010 season. Rule books are given to all members on joining and will be available at the secretaries caravan for all members and non members to view during the show day.

Would all Non-members please note the following restrictions:

Special Beginners Class 3 is for RLRC Members only.

All Novice & Prelim Show jumping & Novice Working Hunter classes are for horses and ponies which have not been placed 1st, 2nd, or 3rd in their respective classes.

Rosettes will be awarded to sixth place in all classes

Would Members and Non-Members please note:

Dogs must be on a lead at all times

Children 16 years and under must not be left unattended at any time

Anyone travelling alone must give the secretary a contact number in the case of accident

All accidents/incidents must be reported to the secretaries caravan immediately.

All competitors MUST wear the correct standard hard hats EN1384, PAS015:1998, ASTM F1163, BSEN14572:2005 or SEI American standard SNELL E2001, ASTM95, SN3838 1998.

The committee reserve the right to alter or cancel any classes or events if necessary

The decision of the judge is final at all times and in all matters.

NOVICE SHOWJUMPING

Entry Fees: Members: £5.50; Visitors: £8.50

Please be aware this arena is specifically for either young and or Novice riders or horses/ponies. The clear round is open to everyone of all ages and abilities.

Arena 1 9:45am start

Clear Round 9:45 am - 11am ONLY

Members - £3 Non Members - £4

Rosettes will be given to all clear rounds

- Class 1** **Lead Rein Jumping (T)** Entries close 11am
Open to children 3-8 years on lead rein
- Class 2** **10yrs & Under Jumping (T)**
- Class 3** **Special Beginners (T)** Fences at approx 40 cm
Split horse/pony if entries allow
MEMBERS ONLY CLASS
- Class 4** **Novice (T)** Fences at approx 60 cm
Split horse/pony if entries allow
- Class 5** **Prelim (T)** Fences at approx 68 cm
Split horse/pony if entries allow

Classes 2-5 will close as soon as the entry sheet has left the secretaries caravan for the judge, NO entries will be taken after this point.

OPEN SHOWJUMPING

Entry Fees: Members: £5.50; Visitors: £8.50

Arena 2 10.15am start

- Class 6** **Warm Up** Fences max 75 cm
Entries close 10.15am
Split Horse/Pony if entries allow
- Class 7** **Intermediate (T)** Fences approx 75 cm - 85 cm
Split Horse/Pony if entries allow
- Class 8** **Variety Class (T)** Fences approx 75cm - 85cm

May 9th – Pairs, **June 27th** - Higher and Wider (one jump getting higher, and one jump wider in each round) . Only 2 jumps in this competition, plus warm up fence, **July 18th** – Horse & Hound, **August 22nd** -Top Score (how many jumps can you do in a set time)

- Class 9** **Open (T)** Fences at approx 95 cm
Class will not start before 1pm
Split Horse/Pony if entries allow
- Class 10** **Advanced (T)** Fences at max 1m
Split Horse/Pony if entries allow

All classes will be 2 round competitions, i.e. one round then jump off against the clock. With exception of the Variety class where rules will differ dependant on class on the day.

Classes 7-10 will close as soon as the entry sheet has left the secretaries caravan for the judge, NO entries will be taken after this point.

WORKING HUNTER RING

Entry Fees: Members: £5.50; Visitors: £8.50

Arena 3 10am start

All classes will close as soon as the entry sheet has left the secretaries caravan for the judge, NO entries will be taken after this point.

- Class 11 Riding Club Pony/Horse (T)**
Will be expected to jump up to 2 fences at judges discretion. Height not to exceed 65 cm
Snaffle Bridle ONLY to be worn
- Class 12 Ridden Hunter/Hunter Type Pony (T)**
Judged on type, confirmation and manners. Judges will require exhibits to do individual show to include walk, trot, gallop on, halt and stand still. Any bridle may be worn. Ponies up to 148cm. Horses exceeding 148 cm.
- Class 13 Novice Working Hunter Pony/Horse (T)**
Ponies not to exceed 153cm. Fences approx. 70cm. To be judged on jumping, manners, confirmation, type and freedom of action.
Jumping to be followed immediately by show
- Class 14 Open Working Hunter Pony/Horse (T)**
Ponies not to exceed 153cm. Fences approx. 85cm. To be judged on jumping, manners, confirmation, type and freedom of action.
Jumping to be followed immediately by show
- Class 15 Nursery Stakes**
Ponies not to exceed 143cm. Fences approx. 40 cm
Riders not to have attained their 12th birthday before 1st January in current year.
To be judged on jumping, manners, confirmation and type.
Jumping to be followed immediately by show

Competitors who enter the Novice or Open sections of our Working Hunter classes are not eligible to compete in the Nursery Stakes, other than H/C.

INDOOR DRESSAGE

Rules

- All competitions will be run under the British Riding Club Rules.
- All classes are open to both Juniors and Seniors if numbers sufficient.
- Rosettes will be awarded to sixth place if numbers allow.
- Correct dress must be worn – Hard hats to standard EN1384, PAS015:1998, ASTM F1163, BSEN14572:2005 or SEI American standard SNELL E2001, ASTM95, SN3838 1998
- Club numbers must be worn by members. Non-members to wear allocated number.
- No refunds will be given after times have been issued.
- Only competitors may work in a horse/pony before a class.
- **Entries will be taken on a first come first served basis.**

Walk & Trot Classes: No Horse and Rider combination to have placed 1st in any RLRC Dressage Championships.

Preliminary Restricted Classes: RLRC Members Only – No Horse and Rider combination to have been placed 1st in any RLRC Dressage Championship.

Veteran: A rosette to be given to the highest placed Veteran horse/pony (over the age of 15 yrs by the 1st January 2010) in each class. Age to be stated on entry form. Points will be awarded to RLRC members towards the Veteran Dressage Championship Trophy 2010.

Rearsby Lodge Riding Club expects everyone attending shows to adhere to these rules, which will be displayed on the notice board.

Trophies 2010

Annual RLRC Dressage trophies to be awarded in the following categories:

Walk & Trot Test; Preliminary Restricted, Preliminary (Classes 2 & 3 combined), Novice (Classes 4 & 5 combined), Elementary, Veteran over 15 yrs by the 1st January 2010.
