### **Rearsby Lodge Riding Club Senior Show Jumping Teams – 2010**

The Indoor **Novice** Show Jumping Area Qualifier will be held at Trent Valley E.C., Southwell, Notts on Sunday on 21<sup>st</sup> November.

**This a team only competition, we cannot enter individuals so we can only have teams of four.** Teams will jump two rounds, with the best three scores from each round to count for the team total. If one member of a team of four is eliminated in the first round they are allowed to jump in the second round. In the event of a tie, there could also be a third `jump off` round.


Under BRC (British Riding Club) competition rules you **MUST** have a valid vaccination certificate which must accompany the animal to the competition. The certificate must be valid showing the initial 3 vaccinations. (The first 2 injections are to be given no less than 21 days and no more than 92 days apart). In addition a first booster injection must be given no less than 150 days and no more than 215 days after the second injection of the primary vaccination. Subsequently, booster injections must be given at intervals of not more 1 year apart. **VERY IMPORTANT, SO PLEASE SEND ME A PHOTOCOPY OF YOUR VACCINATION CERTIFICATE TO ENSURE YOU ARE LEGAL!**

**Senior Novice:** First Round maximum height 80cm, maximum spread 85cm, maximum spread of a triple bar 1m; Second Round maximum height 85cm, maximum spread 90cm

For every full year during which a horse/pony with BSJA winnings remains unregistered £50 may be deducted in order to calculate eligibility for BRC competitions. SJAI points should be converted into pounds by multiplying by 9 (for horses) or 2.5 (for ponies). If a horse or pony is re-registered with BSJA/SJAI all previous winnings/points gained prior to being un-registered will be re-activated.

I think I have given you most of the information that you need, except to say that when you decide to enter I will need a cheque from you made payable to RLRC in the sum of £17.00 by mid October. Not a huge amount for such excitement!
