

**Rearsby Lodge Riding Club Area 16 Senior Horse Trials Qualifier**  
 To be held at Eland Lodge Equestrian, Draycott in the Clay, Derbyshire  
 Sunday, 20<sup>th</sup> June 2010

The qualifier for this event has three sections, **Open, Intermediate and Novice.**

Detailed below are the relevant dressage tests, and heights of xc and sj for each of the three sections.

**\*Not to have completed a BE novice competition within the competition year.**

This is a team and individual qualifier, and team members automatically count as an individual also.

**The Area 16 Committee are subsidising this qualifier substantially this year.**

Eland Lodge are providing the majority of their British Eventing supporters who run the affiliated event, i.e. fence judge, scorers, timekeepers, first aid, etc. This will provide an event which is run to a BE standard event, but at a much smaller cost. Therefore Rearsby Riding Club hope to send a good turnout of teams to support this qualifier, as it really is 'in our neck of the woods'.

If the event is not well supported, in future years the qualifier could revert to being held at less prominent venues, with less qualified help.

If you would like to take part in representing our Riding Club, please return the Attached form, with a full copy of your Flu Vaccination Certificate, and A5 SAE, and a cheque for £35.00, made payable to Rearsby Lodge Riding Club.  
**No cheque, no entry.**

We require cheques at the latest by 22<sup>nd</sup> May. All entries for team events Have to be received approximately 4 weeks before the relevant qualifier.

**The Championships are held at Aston le Walls on 6<sup>th</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup> August 2010.**

The Novice Championships is run over 2 days and incorporates roads and tracks and steeplechase, with the cross country section.

The Intermediate and Open Championships are held over 3 days, with roads and tracks and steeplechase within the cross country section.

**Important note re Full Vaccination Histories**

All certificates will be checked at all Area Qualifiers and at all Championships Before a horse is allowed to compete, and anyone with an invalid certificate will not be permitted to compete. Any horse or pony disqualified at an area qualifier will be reported to the BRC Office. If that team qualifies for a championship, the disqualified pony/horse cannot be replaced with a reserve, and the team must remain a team of three.

**Vaccination certificates must show –**

Primary Vaccination - Two injections, the 2<sup>nd</sup> between 21 and 92 days after the first.

First booster - An injection 150 and 215 days after 2<sup>nd</sup> injection.

Annual booster - An injection not more than 1 year after the preceding Injection.

If you do need to re-start your vaccinations, only the first two injections need to have been given before the horse/pony may compete.

None of the vaccinations may be given within the preceding 7 days, including the day of the competition.
