

Rearsby Lodge Riding Club Junior Show Jumping Teams – 2010:

We would like to invite you to represent your club at the Show Jumping Area Qualifiers, which are held in the summer at Eagle Moor on July 11th.

Each team (and Rearsby Lodge can enter more than one) will jump two rounds, with the best three scores from each round to count for the team total. If one member of a team of four is eliminated in the first round they are allowed to jump in the second round. In the event of a tie, there could also be a third 'jump off' round.

Under BRC (British Riding Club) competition rules you MUST have a valid vaccination certificate which relates to their horse/pony, and must accompany the animal to the competition. The certificate must be valid showing the initial 3 vaccinations. (The first 2 injections are to be given no less than 21 days and no more than 92 days apart). In addition a first booster injection must be given no less than 150 days, and no more than 215 days after the second injection of the primary vaccination. Subsequently, booster injections must be given at intervals of not more 1 year apart.

Everyone is encouraged to take part in any of the 3 classes listed below. To qualify to the National Championships in September, is a major achievement to any young horse-rider and Rearsby Lodge teams past and present have achieved this goal.

Class 1 – Junior Novice: Horse/pony must not to have won any money in BSJA or SJAI points. All previous winnings can be reduced by £50 for each full year that the registration has lapsed. They must not have won any BE or IHTS Horse Trials Points. A horse/pony may not compete in the Novice and Open sections of an official BRC competition in the same competition year.

First Round 2`6”

Second round 2`9”

Class 2 – Junior Open : Horse/pony not to have won a total of £400 BSJA. Again £50 can be subtracted for each full year that the horse remains unregistered.

First Round 3`0”

Second round 3`3”

Class 3 – Junior Style Jumping:

This is a lovely 'warm up' class to the above classes. Judged on both horse and rider over a set of approx. 8 fences, to include a double and a style (skinny fence), and must be ridden in a snaffle bridle and preferably no martingale to avoid penalties. This class normally has a lot less entries, and can be ridden by both Novice and Open Juniors.

Jumps approx 2`6” – 2`9”.

All you have to do now is let me know if you are interested in any of above. Training can be arranged for team members and the club pay for entries/plus extra training should you qualify for the championships.

Please complete the attached form asap and return to me, with a copy of your horse/pony flu vac – and I can then keep you informed of any other team Show jumping events that may be of interest to you and you can become a member of `Team Rearsby`. We are hoping to be sporting `team colours` too this season, so please join in.
